

Student Employee Wage Increase Effective January 1st, 2025

We hope to bring to your attention that effective January 1st there will be an increase in the ranges of the student employee wage scale. The minimum wage for each classification is increasing. This means that all student employees of all levels of classification will be subject to this change whether they work in Education or Operations.

Action Required

For those that are responsible for student wages in your department, we ask that prior to the end of year, you review the new ranges listed in the link below and verify that all your student employees' wages will fall into the correct range given their classification.

If the wage correctly falls into the appropriate range for the classification, there is no additional action required. If it does not, the wage will need to be adjusted.

Please note that Human Resources will automatically move all student employees that are classified as level 1 to the new minimum hourly rate of \$19.00. All other wage adjustments will need to be submitted at the department level via EPAF or PA (depending on your process).
